Results from National Test called *PLAN*

WHAT IS *PLAN*?

- *PLAN* is the second step in a national testing program that ends with the *ACT* college entrance exam. In Kentucky, 10th grade students began *PLAN* testing in the fall of 2007.
- Students are tested in English, reading, math, and science.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF *PLAN*?

PLAN measures students' current academic development, gauges their readiness for college, and gives students and families information to help in the selection of courses for the junior and senior years. The test also provides information that can help students think about career preparation. *PLAN* is a good predictor of success on the *ACT* college entrance exam.

HOW DID OUR SCHOOL SCORE?
